Summary of Grounds for Probation Order:

1. Pennsylvania Institute of Taxidermy must demonstrate that the school is financially sound with resources sufficient for the proper operation of the school and the discharge of obligations to students (*Section I (C)(1), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
2. Pennsylvania Institute of Taxidermy must demonstrate that the school's Program Advisory Committee meetings include at least three members in attendance that represent the employment community and/or practitioners from the program area and that the school regularly conducts at least two Program Advisory Committee meetings annually (*Section II (A)(5), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
