This letter is to inform the U.S. Department of Education of the final actions taken by the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (“ACCSC” or “the Commission”) for the institutions listed below.

I. Final Adverse Action:

The Audio Recording Technology Institute located in Orlando, Florida (School #M070230) has elected not to appeal the Commission’s December 9, 2009 decision to deny the school’s Application for Renewal of Accreditation and to remove the school from ACCSC’s list of accredited institutions. Accordingly, the Commission’s action to revoke the accreditation of Audio Recording Technology Institute is final and effective December 22, 2009.

II. Adverse Action Pending a Decision to Appeal:

The Commission has notified American Pacific College located in Van Nuys, California (School #M070739) of its adverse action to revoke the school’s accreditation pending the school’s exercise of its appeal rights as set forth in the ACCSC Standards of Accreditation. The school must submit its Letter of Intent to Appeal by December 29, 2009. If the school elects not to appeal the Commission’s adverse action, the revocation action will become final. If the school elects to appeal the Commission’s adverse action, the school will continue to operate as an accredited institution subject to a Probation Order until such time as the appeal has been heard and resolved.
