

ADVERTISING OF ACCREDITED STATUS

1. An accredited school may publish official affiliation with the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges of Technology by imprinting the ACCSCT seal on advertising, literature, or other publications.



2. When citing accreditation status in advertising, literature, or publications, only the following references may be used:

- a. Accredited by the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges of Technology (ACCSCT).

This reference may be used alone; with the name of the school immediately preceding; as a part of a sentence prefixed by phrases such as:

This school is
Our school is
(Name of school) is

- b. Accredited Member/School/College,*
Accrediting Commission of Career Schools
and Colleges of Technology.

- c. Accredited Member/School/College,*
ACCSCT.

This format may be used only when dictated by limited advertising space.

- d. The following reference must be used for a branch or satellite location:

(Name of branch/satellite location) is accredited by the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges of Technology (ACCSCT) as a (branch/satellite location) of (name of main school/branch).

3. The following statement may also be used immediately following the above references:

The Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges of Technology is listed by the U.S. Department of Education as a nationally recognized accrediting agency.

4. A non-member school will not make any promotional use of its application for accreditation prior to a grant of accreditation.
