Press Release: ACCSC's Executive Director Testifies in Congress on Role of Accreditation

With an increase in Congressional interest in ensuring the strength of accreditation as a gatekeeper to Title IV funds, the House Subcommittee on Higher Education and Workforce Training hosted a hearing on June 13, 2013 entitled, “**Keeping College Within Reach: Discussing Program Quality Through Accreditation**” which provided members of the Subcommittee with an opportunity to explore a variety of proposals to strengthen accreditation and its gatekeeping role, as well as to discuss alternative models. At the behest of the subcommittee, ACCSC's Executive Director, Dr. Michale McComis, accepted an invitation to provide testimony at the hearing.
