The Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges (“ACCSC” or “the Commission”) acknowledges that following schools operated by the Center for Excellence in Higher Education (“CEHE”) closed and ceased providing education and training effective August 1, 2021:

- California College San Diego – National City, California
- California College San Diego – San Marcos, California
- CollegeAmerica – Phoenix, Arizona

Pursuant to *Section VII (P)(6) & (Q)(4), Rules of Process and Procedure, Standards of Accreditation*, the Commission considers a school to have had its accreditation withdrawn if the school closes without notification or closes without an approved teach-out plan (to include as necessary an approved teach-out agreement) that the school faithfully executes. The above-listed institutions:

- Failed to notify ACCSC prior to closure on August 1, 2021;¹
- Failed to faithfully execute teach-out plans on file with ACCSC; and
- Closed without an approved teach-out agreement as had been required by ACCSC.²

Accordingly, the accreditation for each of these campuses is considered withdrawn effective August 1, 2021.

In accordance with *Section X (C)&(D), Rules of Process and Procedure, Standards of Accreditation*, the reasons for the withdrawal are made public and provided to the U.S. Department of Education, appropriate state agencies, and appropriate accrediting agencies.

APPEAL PROCESS AND PROCEDURE

CEHE may opt to appeal this determination. Details regarding the appeal procedures are outlined in *Section VIII, Rules of Process and Procedures, Standards of Accreditation*.

- If the school elects to appeal this withdrawal, the school must sign and return the enclosed Letter of Intent to Appeal a Commission Decision, along with the Appeal Expense Fee of \$6,000.00 for each campus, **on or before September 27, 2021.**
- If the school elects to appeal this withdrawal, the school’s Application for Appeal of a Commission Decision and Grounds for Appeal must be submitted **on or before October 17, 2021.**

- If CEHE elects not to appeal the withdrawal of the schools' accreditation, this determination will become final as of August 1, 2021. The school may submit **comments on or before September 27, 2021** in accordance with the enclosed Public Comment Disclosure Form. Comments submitted by a school will accompany any public disclosure of a final Commission action pursuant to *Section X (D)(4), Rules of Process and Procedure, Standards of Accreditation*.
