\* In accordance with ACCSC’s Standards of Accreditation, in instances where a school closes without completing the education for all enrolled students prior to the closure; having an approved teach-out plan (in include teach-out agreement(s) as may be required that the school adheres to; or having made formal arrangements for all students to complete their education elsewhere through transfer credit, articulation, or as part of a teach-out agreement, the Commission will consider a school to have its accreditation withdrawn as of the date of the school closure (*Section VII (P)(6) and (Q)(4) Rules of Process and Procedure, Standards of Accreditation*). Accordingly, if Hussian College elects not to appeal, the Commission’s decision to withdraw the school’s accreditation will be effective July 17, 2023.
