On April 17, 2024, the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges ("ACCSC" or "the Commission") issued a letter to Career College of Northern Nevada located in Sparks, Nevada withdrawing the school's accreditation and informing the school of its right to appeal that decision. As of the date of this letter, the school has not filed the Letter of Intent to Appeal a Commission Decision as provided in the Commission's April 17, 2024 letter. Accordingly, pursuant to Section VII, Rules of Process and Procedure, Standards of Accreditation the Commission's decision to withdraw accreditation of Career College of Northern Nevada located in Sparks, Nevada is final effective February 9, 2024.

At the March 2024 meeting the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges ("ACCSC" or "the Commission") considered the matter of the closure of Career College of Northern Nevada in Sparks, Nevada. ACCSC became aware of the school's apparent closure through media reports on Friday, February 9, 2024. ACCSC contacted the school on Sunday February 11, 2024 to inquire about any teach-out arrangements that may have been made for students. On Monday, February 12, 2024 the school replied via email and indicated that no teach-out arrangements were made.

Based on the information available, the Commission determined that the school closed without an approved teach-out plan or formal arrangements. Accordingly, the Commission considers the accreditation of Career College of Northern Nevada to be withdrawn effective February 9, 2024 pursuant to Section VII (P)(6) and (Q)(4) Rules of Process and Procedure, Standards of Accreditation. In accordance with Section X(C)&(D), Rules of Process and Procedure, Standards of Accreditation, the reasons for the withdrawal are made public and provided to the U.S. Department of Education, appropriate state agencies, and appropriate accrediting agencies.

## **Appeal and Reapplication Process and Procedure**

Career College of Northern Nevada may opt to appeal the Commission's decision to withdraw accreditation. Details regarding the appeal procedures are outlined in the ACCSC Rules of Process and Procedures, Standards of Accreditation.

- If Career College of Northern Nevada elects to appeal this decision, then the school must sign and return the
  enclosed Letter of Intent to Appeal a Commission Decision, along with the Appeal Expense Fee of
  \$8,000.00, on or before April 29, 2024.
- If Career College of Northern Nevada elects to appeal this decision, then the school's Application for Appeal of a Commission Decision and Grounds for Appeal must be submitted **on or before May 17, 2024.**
- If Career College of Northern Nevada elects not to appeal this decision, then the Commission's decision will become effective as of February 9, 2024. The school may submit comments on or before April 29, 2024 in accordance with the enclosed Public Comment Disclosure Form. Comments submitted by the school will accompany any public disclosure of a final Commission action pursuant to Section X (D)(4), Rules of Process and Procedure, Standards of Accreditation.
