

ACCSC DISCLOSURE OF COMMISSION ACTION SUMMARY OF GROUNDS FOR WARNING ACTION

CENTRAL CALIFORNIA SCHOOL OF CONTINUING EDUCATION (#B072603) 226 COALINGA PLAZA COALINGA, CALIFORNIA 93210

December 30, 2025

The Accrediting Commission of Career School and Colleges has issued a Warning to Central California School of Continuing Education (“CCSCE-Coalinga”) located in Coalinga, California. Pursuant to ACCSC’s *Rules of Process and Procedure*, the Commission will publish a summary of the reasons for the Warning. The school has an opportunity to submit a response to demonstrate corrective action regarding the Commission’s grounds for the Warning.

1. CCSCE-Coalinga must demonstrate that the school is an independent separate facility and that the branch campus:
 - Has its own faculty and administrative or supervisory organization (*Section VIII (A)(1)(a)(iii), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*);
 - Has its own budgetary and hiring authority (*Section VIII (A)(1)(a)(iv), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*); and
 - Provides all necessary educational resources and student services (e.g., advising, testing, library resources, financial aid, employment assistance, etc.) required by accrediting standards authority (*Section VIII (A)(1)(a)(v), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
2. CCSCE- Coalinga must demonstrate adequate management and administrative capacity, as follows:
 - That the school has full-time on-site supervision by an individual or team with the appropriate combination of education, experience, and demonstrated ability to lead and manage a post-secondary educational institution in compliance with accrediting standards (*Section I (A)(1)(a), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*);
 - That the school has a sufficient number of managers and administrative employees necessary to support the school’s operations, student services, and educational programs (*Section I (A)(1)(c), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*); and
 - That the school has appropriate administrative and operational policies and procedures to which the school adheres, reviews, and updates as needed (*Section I (A)(1)(d), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
3. CCSCE-Coalinga must demonstrate the following with regard to its financial responsibility (*Section I (C)(2), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*):
 - CCSCE-Coalinga did not demonstrate that the school prepares an annual financial budget that allocates working capital for expenditures required to ensure the proper operation of the school and the discharge of its obligations to students as well as for institutional improvement and faculty development activities and

- CCSCE-Coalinga did not demonstrate that the school monitors its budgetary projections in relation to actual income and expenses on a regular basis throughout the fiscal year.
4. CCSCE-Coalinga must demonstrate that the school engages in institutional assessment and improvement activities (*Section I (B)(1) Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
 5. CCSCE-Coalinga must demonstrate that the school maintains internal verifiable employment records in accordance with the requirements set forth in *Appendix VII, Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*.
 6. CCSCE-Coalinga must demonstrate that the school enforces a policy of acceptable student attendance as outlined in the school catalog (*Section VII (A)(3)(b), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
 7. CCSCE-Coalinga must demonstrate that the school internally reviews and evaluates its recruiting policies and procedures and the performance of personnel involved in recruiting activities for compliance with accrediting standards and applicable law and regulation at least once annually and maintains documentation of the review and evaluation (*Section IV (A)(9), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
