

ACCSC DISCLOSURE OF COMMISSION ACTION SUMMARY OF GROUNDS FOR WARNING ACTION

The Accrediting Commission of Career School and Colleges has issued a Warning to Colegio Tecnico de Electricidad Galloza located in Aguada, Puerto Rico. Pursuant to ACCSC's *Rules of Process and Procedure*, the Commission will publish a summary of the reasons for the Warning. The school has an opportunity to submit a response to demonstrate corrective action regarding the Commission's grounds for the Warning.

1. CTEG must demonstrate full-time on-site supervision by an individual or team with the appropriate combination of education, experience, and demonstrated ability to lead and manage and post-secondary educational institution in compliance with accrediting standards (*Section I (A)(1)(a), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*) and participate in ongoing development and training activities that support their particular roles in the school including as applicable, ACCSC requirements and procedures (*Section I (A)(3), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
2. CTEG must demonstrate that the school conducts at least one regularly scheduled Program Advisory Committee ("PAC") meeting annually and that the school maintains written and detailed minutes of each meeting which include a comprehensive and clear description of the review and commentary made by the school representatives and the PAC members (*Section II (A)(4)(b), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation & Appendix III Program Requirements, Standards of Accreditation*).
3. CTEG must demonstrate that the school verifies prior work experience for all faculty members and that faculty teaching technical and occupationally related courses have a minimum of three years of related practical work experience in the subject area(s) taught (*Section III (A)(4) & Section III (B)(5), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
4. CTEG must demonstrate that personnel whose primary responsibilities are to engage in recruiting and admissions functions and that the school's personnel are trained and qualified to engage in recruiting activities (*Section IV (A)(5), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*) and that the school does not permit its representatives whose primary responsibilities include recruiting and admissions activities to assist prospective students in completing application forms for financial aid (*Section IV (A)(12), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
5. CTEG must demonstrate that the school's transcript includes the cumulative grade point average and the date of termination or withdrawal (*Section VI(B)(2), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
